Evaluations

- Date & Time TBD
- Evaluations give the coaches the opportunity to see all players conduct some basic baseball skills. It provides the coaches insight into each player's abilities and it helps to ensure that all teams are drafted with players at all skill levels.

Team Drafts

- Date & Time TBD
- Location: PGA National
- Any coach that has a child playing in the Spring season, this player will be automatically added to their team. Also, for any siblings that play in the same age group, they will be drafted to the same team unless a parent request otherwise.
- With over 500 players in the Spring season the league cannot accept any other request.

Team Information

- After the notification of what team each child will be playing on, the coach will be communicating with all parents to introduce themselves and provide additional information regarding the practice schedule and expectations for the season.

Team Practice

- Team practices will start late January and run through February.
- Each team will be assigned 2 practices a week
- Once games start, field space permitting, the league will assign 1 practice a week.

Opening Day

Games and Scheduling

- All age groups games will start the last week of February.
- The official game schedule will be emailed to each parent via Blue Sombrero prior to the first week of games. With approximately 500 players, the scheduling process takes some time and review before the final schedule is posted.
- Divisions: ***Subject to change***
 - T-Ball: Monday & Friday 5:15 pm
 - Rookie: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday at 5:15 pm and Saturday Mornings
 - Minor: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday at 7 pm and early Saturday afternoons
 - Majors: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday at 7 pm
 - Senior: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday 7 pm and Saturdays

Uniforms & Equipment

- Each player will receive a jersey and hat, you will be responsible for the pants and socks. The pants and socks color will be determined once you are placed on a team.
- Players will need cleats, a glove and a helmet.

- All communication is through Blue Sombrero email or text messages

- You can also download the Dick's Team Manager app on your Apple or Android device. Use your Blue Sombrero login and password. This will give you mobile access to your child's team roster, game reminders, etc.

Weather Notifications and Make Up Games

- We will email and text parents if we have any rain outs, please note the City of Palm Beach Gardens makes the decisions on field closures.
- We will usually not make the decision until close to 5 pm as we do our best to get the games played.
- If a game is rained out, the Board will attempt to reschedule it to be played at a later date.

T-Ball Division: Developmental & Competitive

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Developmental Division

The Developmental Division will consist of fun games and drills which are designed for the beginner player. The program will be overseen by professional baseball coaches with the expertise needed to teach and reinforce proper fundamentals. Parents of athletes in this program are strongly encouraged to volunteer to coach to help our professional trainers execute these drills, so please volunteer! Parent coaches will learn a lot as well!

Program Structure

Athletes will be assigned to teams that will work together through drills and games to develop fundamental skills. Training sessions will take place on Monday's, Wednesday's and Friday's on the Miracle Fields (turf fields on the East side of the park) and run for 2 hours. Each session will conclude with a game. As the season progresses, the length of the games will increase.

Program Objectives/Goals

The core purpose of the Developmental Program is to teach base fundamentals. Before moving to the Competitive Division, players should be able to:

- Throw and catch consistently
- Know where the bases are
- Understand where positions are on the field.
- Understand the basic rules of the game (3 outs, etc.)

Competitive Division

The Competitive Division has been created so more advanced players can learn to compete in competitive games. This division will play by the Official Cal Ripken Baseball Rules. The purpose is to better prepare players for the speed and style of play they will encounter as they move up into the Rookie Division (Machine Pitch). Games will be 6 innings or a maximum of 90 minutes, whichever comes first.

Program Structure

Athletes will be assigned to a team. Players will have more hands-on instruction and get the maximum number of innings played so that players can gain the most experience during the course of the season. This division will encourage a very aggressive style of play. Teams will meet on Monday's and Friday's for practices and games.

Program Objectives/Goals

The core purpose of the Competitive Division is to build upon the base fundamentals that athletes have already begun to master. Areas of focus will be on:

- Defensive movement off the ball (what to do when the ball is NOT hit to you)
- Base running, recognizing when to run
- The importance of outfield play
- Situational baseball, getting the lead runner
